Session Overview

This web seminar will focus on effective systems for gathering data and documenting function to support coding decisions for the MDS 3.0 Section GG. The session will include review of Section GG items used to determine PDPM function scores and how those scores are calculated as well as how to establish interdisciplinary approaches to ensure accurate assessment and coding of Section GG items.
